


The majority (71%) of people in Saudi Arabia think things in the country are heading in the right direction.




WORLD SUMMARY: JULY 2017

The majority (60%) of people around the world think things in their country are on the wrong track.





Right direction % change compared with previous month:



Generally speaking, would you say things in this country are heading in the right direction, or are they off on the wrong track?

































METHODOLOGY

METHODOLOGY

The survey is conducted monthly in 26 countries around the world via the Ipsos Online Panel system. The countries included are Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Great Britain, Germany, Hungary, India, Israel, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Peru, Poland, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and the United States of America.

An international sample of 18,550 adults aged 18-64 in Canada, Israel and the US, and aged 16-64 in all other countries, were interviewed between June 23rd and July 7th 2017.

Approximately 1000+ individuals participated on a country by country basis via the Ipsos Online Panel with the exception of Argentina, Belgium, Hungary, India, Israel, Mexico, Peru, Poland, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Sweden and Turkey, where each have a sample of approximately 500+.

Weighting has been employed to balance demographics and ensure that the sample's composition reflects that of the adult population according to the most recent country census data.

A survey with an unweighted probability sample of this size would have an estimated margin of error of \pm - 3.1 percentage points for a sample of 1,000 and an estimated margin of error of \pm - 4.5 percentage points for a 500 sample 19 times out of 20.
